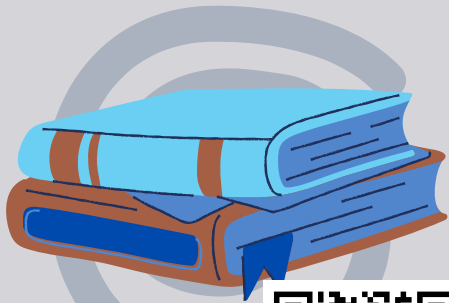

## PATRIOT ETHNICITY

It is a common misconception that most African-American DAR members descend from patriots of color. However, the ethnicities of Daughter Dialogues participants' patriots are as follows:

- 66% have a patriot of European descent
- 20% have an African-American patriot
- 10% have a patriot of mixed race
- 4% have an American Indian patriot

## DID YOU KNOW?

The Daughters of the American Revolution does not keep an official record of the race of its members. Thus, the number of members who are African-American is unknown.
